



9th-12th Grade Homecoming Dance Information

All 9th-12th grade students are invited to the Homecoming dance, “Candyland: How Sweet it is to be a Lion,” which will take place in Westminster Gym on September 17th, from 7:30 – 10 p.m.

Tickets will cost \$15 and should be purchased in advance. Tickets are for sale [HERE](#) until Wednesday, September 14th.

Dance Dress Code: Dress is “Sunday Best” or better. Any student wearing clothing deemed inappropriate will not be let in or may be asked to change. As there has been a positive movement towards more conformity in appropriate skirt length, we ask for similar cooperation in dress and skirt length for the dance. While the dance is early this year, and that may mean warmer weather, please do not use the weather as an invitation to wear more revealing clothing. We encourage students to wear comfortable shoes to the dance, even sneakers! While you may want dress shoes for picture parties, feel free to change out of them for the dance itself.

For females: Ladylike dresses that are appropriate in length and conservative on top are expected.

For males: Boys should be wearing pants, no shorts. Shirt with collar required. Shirt and tie are appropriate, but jackets are not necessary. We will not have a coat check available, so please, if you do wear a jacket, leave it in the car.

It is not necessary to have a date to come to the dance. Students are encouraged to come in groups. The dance begins at 7:30 p.m. and ends at 10 p.m. Students must be present at the dance by 8 p.m., and students may not leave before 9:45 p.m. Dancing must be appropriate, and attire should be such that students are able to move freely and dance. Students who wish to bring a guest from another school are asked to fill out a guest form with the potential guest’s information. The Guest Form can be picked up at Mrs. Laura Boswell’s desk.
