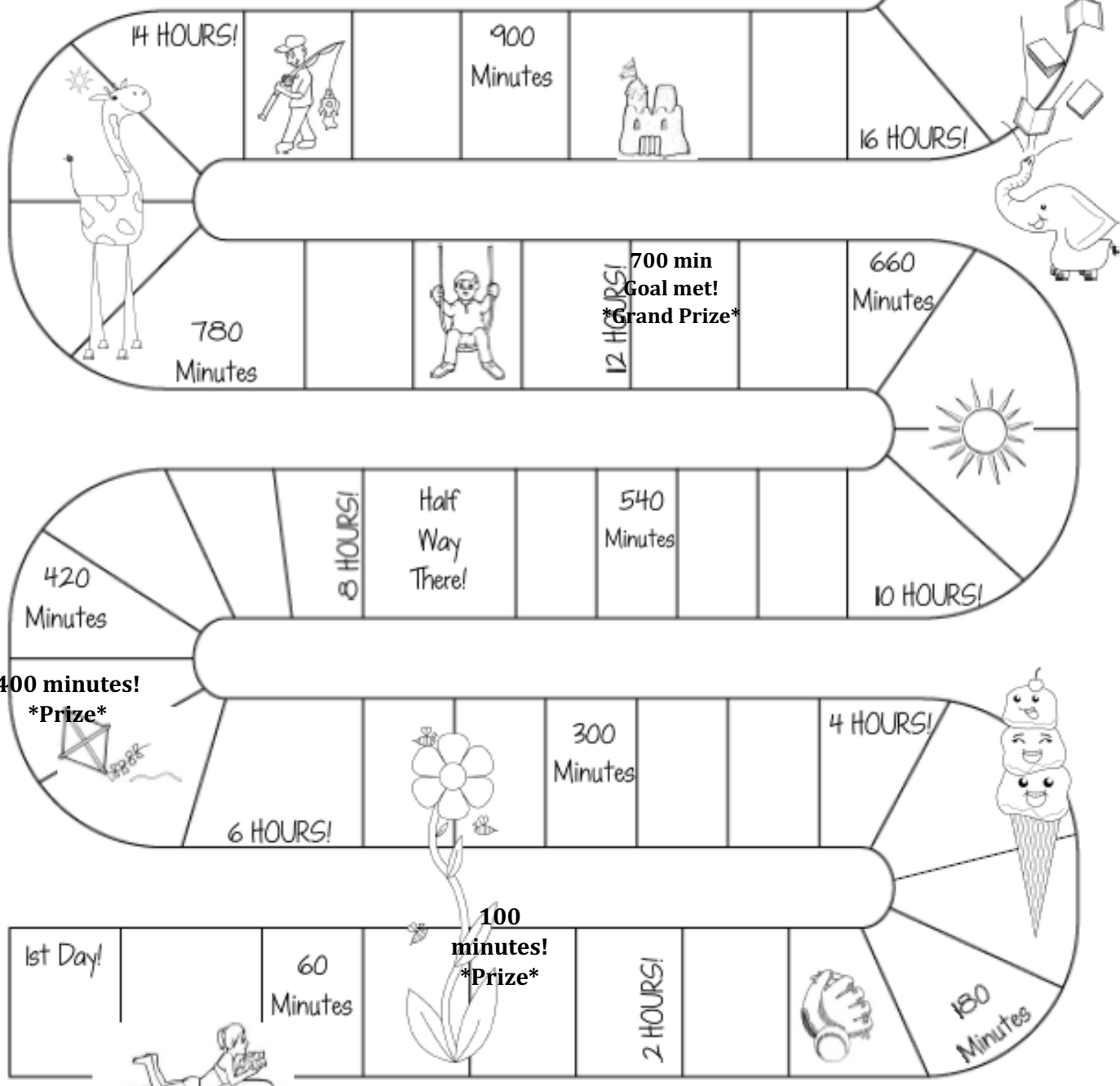
For current WCA students and incoming WCA students, please use this list of SUGGESTED titles to help jumpstart your summer reading.
