- Read <u>one other</u> chapter book of your choice from the list provided. This
 book will be the basis for a book report you will prepare and give after the
 school year starts.

Expectations for the First Weeks of 3rd Grade

- During the <u>first full week</u> of school, the whole class will take the AR test on A Lion to Guard Us. You will want to review the book in preparation for that test.
- 2. During the <u>third full week</u> of school, you will give a book report on the chapter book you chose from the list. Your teacher will explain the requirements and options for that report during your first few days of school, so you will not work on the report during the summer. You **will** need access to your selected book in order to accurately give a report on it.

Please note: WCA will be offering library hours for weekly book checkout in order to help encourage your child's progress throughout the summer. Students who complete the attached summer reading incentive form should bring it back to school in August and will receive a fun prize for their hard work. Required summer reading counts toward their minutes!
