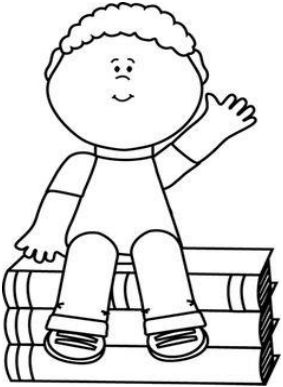
Additional Assignment:
