### Required Assignment:

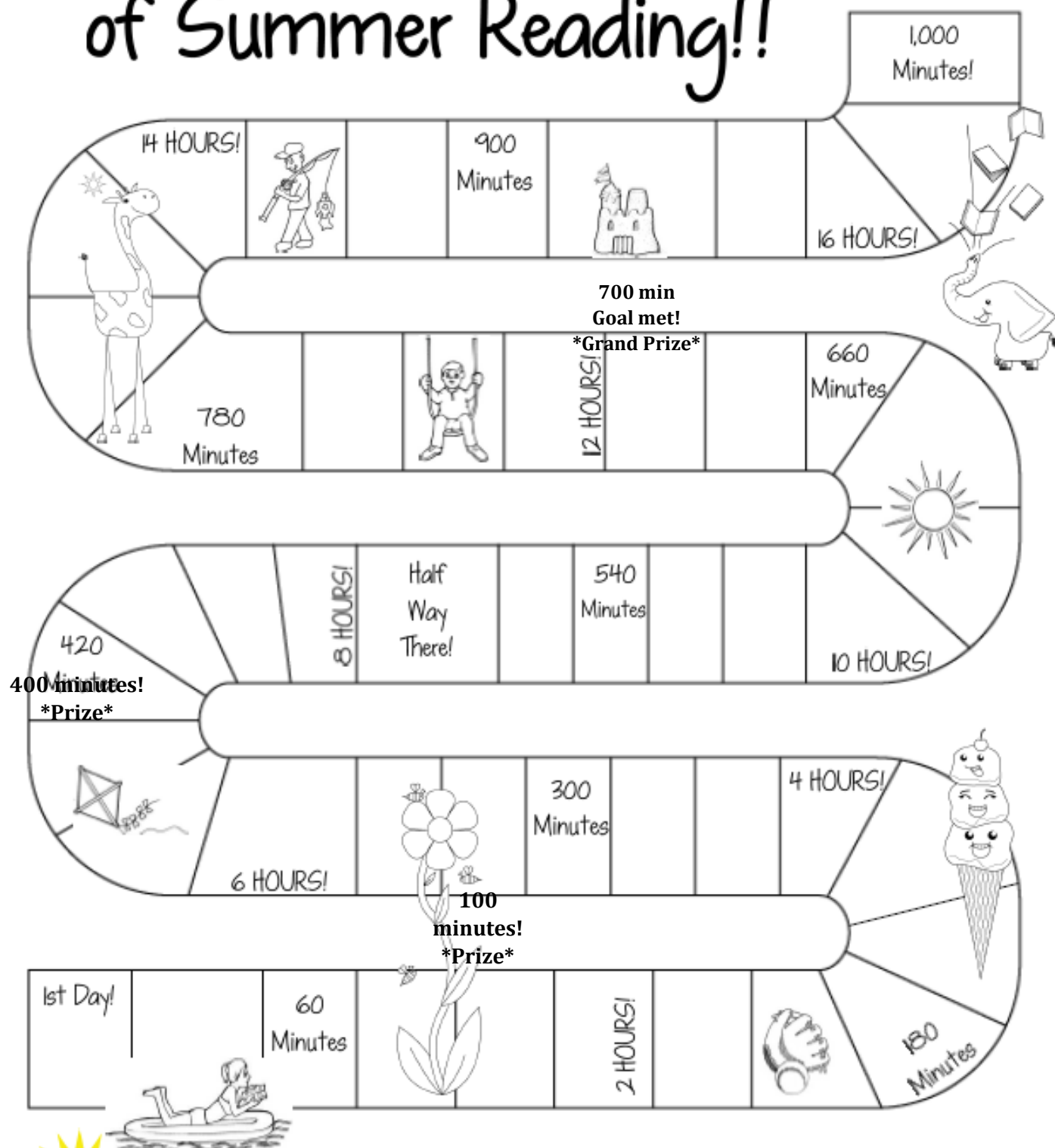
