





Academic Update



The 32 members of the Class of 2024 earned over \$3.6 million in college scholarships. This is the highest scholarship totals in school history. Our recent graduates are attending the following colleges and universities:



Westminster continues to outperform its peers on the SAT scoring an average of 1184 over the last three years. The 2024 Average SAT score was 1143 in Oconee County Schools, 1030 in the state of Georgia, and 995 in the United States. **During this same period, the top 10% of our students scored an average score of 1517.**

95% of our graduates qualify for The Hope Scholarship.

Westminster consistently outperforms its peers in standardized testing. Due to the hard work of our students and faculty, **Westminster exceeded the scores of CESA, SAIS, and GISA schools in 98% of content area scores during the 2024 CTP5 (ERB) Test administration.**

Our faculty averages 17 years of teaching experience and 9 years of service at Westminster.

Westminster currently enrolls 443 students, the highest total in school history.

Westminster offers 15 Advanced Placement and Dual Enrollment Courses.

Westminster is accredited by the Southern Association of Independent Schools and is a candidate member for the Council on Educational Standards and Accountability.



Athletic Update



Our Varsity Boys Soccer team brought home the title of Georgia Independent Athletic Association AA State Champions, making them back to back state champions. The Varsity Girls Soccer team finished as the State Runner Up.

We introduced Rank One, our online platform for athletic forms, advancing and enhancing the parent athletic experience. All physicals are now required to be uploaded to this platform including signatures on the Participation Forms (Concussion, Sudden Cardiac Arrest, Heat Policy) through the portal.

Our middle and high school teams now utilize the Band App as their primary communication platform, simplifying and developing strong communication systems across our athletic programs. Visit the athletics tab of our website to access this information.

Over 85% of our Upper School students participate in at least one sport.

Our Lower School students continue to expand in their athletic opportunities, participating in flag football, premier league basketball, volleyball, and cheerleading.



Fine Arts Update



In the spring, Westminster claimed the title of Georgia Independent School Association AA Literary State Champions.

This fall, our One Act Performance of "Anne of Green Gables" won the title of GISA AA State Runner Up.






Over 70% of our budget is allocated to the salaries and benefits of our faculty and staff.

Campus Expansion



Our Campus Expansion continues to progress and we look forward to the completion of the new Lower School Building in the summer of 2025. The completion of this building will improve the Westminster experience for all students by:

1) Providing a state of the art education space for our Lower School Students which will include:

- 14 classrooms that are significantly larger than our current classrooms
- Art and Music Classrooms
- STEM Lab/ Maker Space
- Dedicated office space for our Lower School Staff
- Media Center
- Increased safety measures

2) Creating more education space for our Upper School Students which will include:

- Additional classroom space for our Upper School in the current Lower School Building
- Removing the aging modulares from campus thus improving the aesthetics and appearance of our campus
- Reducing the distance that Upper School students travel to their classes

3) Improving campus logistics which will include:

- Providing 60 much-needed new parking spaces on campus
- Improving the traffic flow on campus and reducing the time parents spend in carline
