



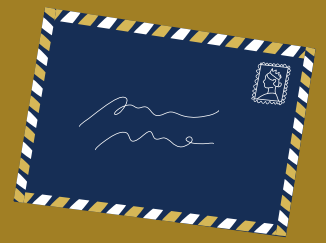

Our faculty averages **16** years of teaching experience and **7** years of service at Westminster.

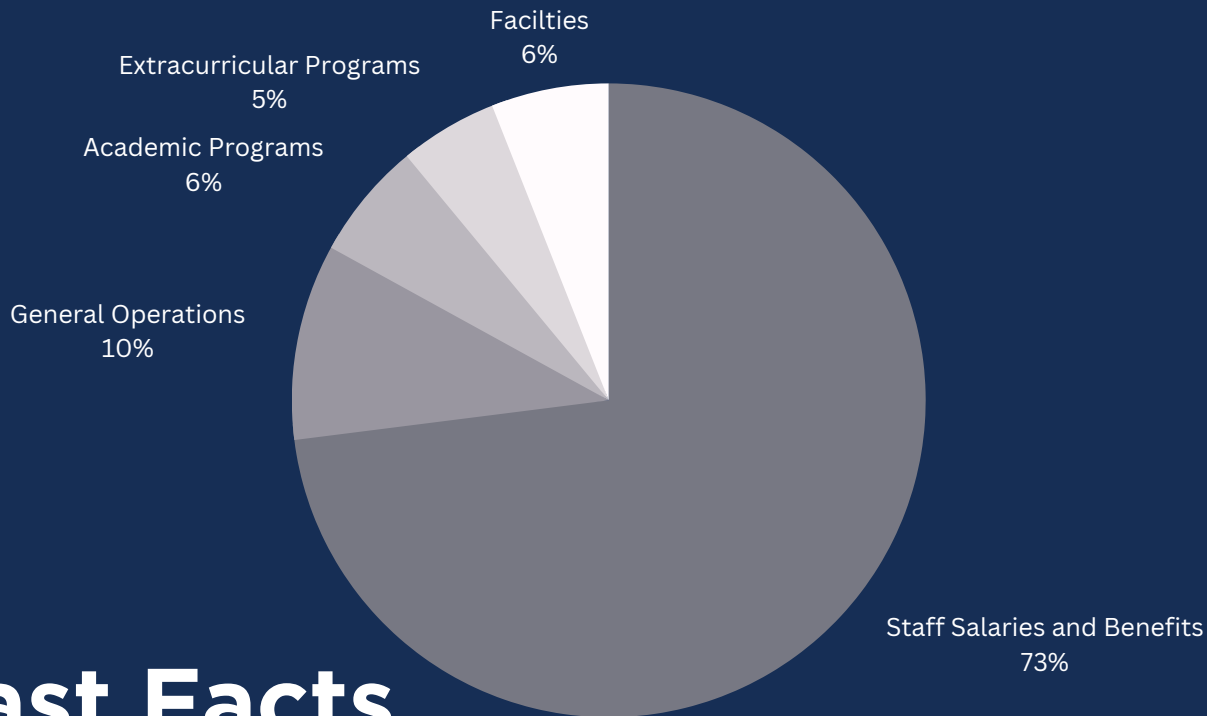


Over **55%** of our faculty hold advanced degrees.



Westminster is accredited by the Southern Association of Independent Schools and is a Candidate School for the Council on Educational Standards and Accountability.

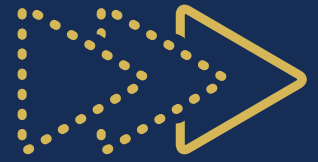
Financial Update



Fast Facts

- Over 70% of our budget is allocated to the salaries and benefits of our faculty and staff.
- At this time, Westminster is debt free!
- Westminster continues to operate in a balanced budget each year and uses any excess funds to fund campus improvements or maintain a healthy reserve.
- The financial model of Westminster is unique when compared to other institutions. Our budget is funded solely through tuition and fees. Annual Fund giving allows the school to make needed non-budgeted improvements to the school's programs and facilities. Most schools rely on Annual Fund giving to supplement the tuition paid by its families to fund their budget.
- During the period of July 1, 2002 through December 31, 2022, Westminster has received gifts and pledges totaling \$225,000. Thank you to our families for your incredible generosity! All of these funds will go towards our campus expansion projects.

Looking to the Future



- In March, we will have our site visit for our Southern Association of Independent Schools Re-Accreditation. This occurs every five years to help us ensure that we are following best practices in our operations and programs. Based on the feedback from prior parent surveys and on needs assessments, we have identified three strategic goals that we will address over the next five years.
 - ➊ Campus Expansion
 - ➋ Enhancement of our Science, Technology, Engineering and Math Programs (STEM)
 - ➌ Continued development of our Academic Support Program
- In the upcoming weeks, we will officially launch our Rise and Build Campus Expansion Campaign. We are excited to officially reveal our plans to provide much-needed space on campus.
- Join us as our lower and middle school students present our spring musical “Annie” on April 27th and 28th.
- We continue to move forward with full membership with the Council on Educational Standards and Accountability. This review process will benchmark Westminster against the top Christian schools across the country.
- Our LIONS LEAD Program is off to an incredible start and the next year will bring some exciting additions to this incredible program. We are hopeful to expand this program to the lower and middle schools in the future.
- With our ever-changing culture, it is imperative that the school continues to provide opportunities for our students to develop a biblical worldview. We continue to focus on the integration of apologetics across all grade levels and will continue to add worldview events within our programming.

✨ We now invite our current Westminster families to secure placement for the 2023-2024 school year. ✨

The regular re-enrollment fees are \$175 per student (\$450 maximum per family). Families completing the online re-enrollment packet before January 31st, 2023 will receive discounted re-enrollment fees of \$75 per student (\$200 maximum per family).

Please note that the fees will increase to \$175 (\$450 maximum per family) as of February 1st, 2023 and to \$250 (\$500 maximum per family) as of April 1st, 2023.

The enrollment fees will be billed through FACTS and will be due no later than March 1st, 2023. Enrollment will open to new families on February 1st, 2023. Seats in each class will be filled as space allows.

Re-enrollment Instructions



To complete our online re-enrollment process, you will access the Family Portal through your existing login.

To access Family Portal:

- Please go to www.factsmgt.com.
- Select Parent Login from the menu bar and FACTS Family Portal from the drop-down menu.
- Type in your username and password. If you have forgotten your username or password, please click on the link provided.
- Our district code is WM-GA.
- After logging in, click on Apply/Enroll in the left menu.
- Click on the Enrollment/Re-enrollment link.

Our Online Enrollment system will open with a link to the enrollment packet for your child. The online process should take approximately 10 minutes to complete. Your information will be saved if you need to exit and return later. If your family is not planning to re-enroll, please follow the steps above and simply click "will not enroll."
