

Personal Technology (not including laptops) will be collected at the beginning of the school day. Students will be informed of the location and the schedule for collection and return of personal technology. Electronics need to be turned off before they are turned in.

Personal Technology

Personal Technology is not necessary in a high school setting and disrupts the learning environment. Personal Technology includes, but is not limited to, the following:

- Cell Phones
- Smartwatches
- Headphones or Earbuds
- MP3-Players
- Tablets
- Etc. (i.e. Any non-school issued personal technology)

We also understand individual students may need to use their phones for logistical or medical reasons. In these unique cases, students may be permitted to utilize the front office to make a call with permission from a staff member or receive a medical exemption (e.g. diabetes monitoring or other health monitoring applications).

Failure to comply will result in the following:

- 1st offense Staff member brings the item to the office and documents the offense. Students will be assigned detention and parents must come pick up the phone from the office.
- 2nd offense Staff member brings the item to the office and documents the offense | Parents must come and pick up the phone and will meet with the administration. | Additional consequences will be applied including but not limited to detention and or suspension.
