Grading System

The high school operates on a two-semester academic year, utilizing an alternating block schedule. Each semester consists of one eighteen-week grading period, concluding with a semester examination that constitutes 15% of the semester grade.

Advanced Placement and dual enrollment courses are not weighted on the transcript. Courses earn one-half of a unit of credit each semester.

The Advanced Placement classes offered at Westminster are Art, Biology, Chemistry, Physics, Pre-Calculus, Calculus AB, English Literature and Composition, and Latin.

US History and Spanish are offered on our campus as dual enrollment classes through Truett McConnell University.
