4. ***Should I Get Flowers?:*** A corsage or bouquet of flowers for your daughter is a terrific idea. Most girls in past years have had a flower of some type. The type of flower you get really depends on what you and your daughter want. We suggest coordinating flower types with your daughter’s classmates so that no one feels “left out.”
5. ***What About Pictures?:*** WCA will have a photographer set up in Mrs. Stephens classroom in the upper school. You often have to prepay for these so you may want to bring a check or credit card in.
